



## Would You Eat This \$2,000 Pizza That's Covered In Real Gold?

A good pizza is worth the splurge, but would you ever buy a pie for \$2,000? It might sound absurd, but that hefty price tag is because this pizza has more than just your run-of-the-mill toppings: It's covered in 24-karat gold.



If you want to get your hands on one of these pizzas, you'll have to head to Industry Kitchen in New York City, where you'll need to place an order two days in advance. In addition to its gold toppings, the pizza is made with a variety of other fancy ingredients: The crust is made from squid ink pizza dough, Stilton cheese from England, and foie gras from France, and then it's all topped with 24-karat gold leaves, gold flakes, French truffles, caviar from the Caspian Sea and edible flowers.
